Key Responsibilities

- Administer and enforce the City's zoning ordinances, subdivision regulations, and comprehensive plan.
- Lead periodic updates to the comprehensive plan to ensure it reflects current and future needs
- Research and recommend zoning amendments, land use policies, and development guidelines.
- Ensure compliance with state and federal land use laws and regulations.

- Experience interpreting and applying building, environmental, and development codes.
- Knowledge of grant funding opportunities related to planning, infrastructure, and development.

- Strong public speaking and presentation skills for community meetings, public hearings, and council sessions.
