

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for Pocomoke City Street Improvements will be received by Pocomoke City, Maryland (herein called the "OWNER") at the office of the City Manager, City Hall, 101 Clarke Avenue, Pocomoke City, Maryland 21851, until **2:00 p.m. local time on Tuesday, April 28, 2026**, at which time bids will be opened publicly and read aloud.

Work generally consists of milling and resurfacing of approximately 23,000 square yards of bituminous concrete, installation of 14 ADA sidewalk ramps, and removal and replacement of deteriorated curb and sidewalks in various locations.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond payable to the Owner for five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Pocomoke City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and/or waive informalities or irregularities, and/or to accept or reject any items of any bid, as it may deem best for its interest. The bids will be evaluated, and award will be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
